4) How can a believer in Jesus Christ be ashamed of Him and His words?

Read *Mark 9:33-34*

5) What events happened prior to these verses that may have fueled the conversation among the disciples over who was “the greatest”?

Read *Mark 9:35-37*

6) What was Jesus’ main point? Why do you think Jesus used a child to illustrate His point?
