Key Truth:

Giving is a test of trust.

Four Observations from Malachi 3:6-12:

- 1. Malachi 3:10 is the only place in Scripture where God gives His people **permisson** to test Him. (Deuteronomy 6:16)
- 2. In difficult times God's people will always be tempted to give less than their **best**. (Malachi 1:7-14)
- 3. Tithing or giving has always been God's way of *financing* His work. (Malachi 3:5; Deuteronomy 14:22-29)
- 4. The primary purpose of the tithe was and is to put God **first** in our lives. (Deuteronomy 14:22-23; Matthew 6:21)
