- 4. Leaders who finished well/strong

For our struggle is not against flesh and blood, but against the rulers, against the authorities, against the powers of this dark world and against the spiritual forces of evil in the heavenly realms." - The ambush of ABUNDANCE.
- 3. The ambush of an ABANDONED family.

Four Questions Every Person Must Ask and Answer Correctly If They Want to Finish Strong:

- 1. Are there at least 1-2 people in my life who I can truly get honest with and rely on for friendship, support, and accountability?
- 2. Am I spending personal time with the Lord praying and reading the Scripture each day?
- 3. Am I currently spending a significant amount of time with any attractive person who is not my spouse?
- 4. Have I convinced myself that a moral failure will never happen to me?


