Two key evidences that *pride* is beginning to creep into our life:

1. *Forgetfulness*

“Satan does not fill us with hatred of God, but with forgetfulness of God.” Dietrich Bonhoeffer

2. *Arrogance*

“An insulting way of thinking or behaving that comes from believing that you are better, smarter, or more important than other people.” Merriam-Webster Dictionary

Key Truth:

If we do not daily crush our *pride* then our *pride* will eventually crush us!

My Next Steps:

- This week I will ask my spouse or a trusted friend to point out areas of pride they can see in my life.
- This week I will have a discussion with my family about areas in which we might be “forgetting” God.
- This week I will memorize Proverbs 16:18, “Pride goes before destruction, a haughty spirit before a fall.”
- This week I will read all of Psalm 103.
