

Grace (Charis / Gratia) = "*kindness* or favor" Westminster Dictionary of Theological Terms

There are two tracks upon which grace can flow:

 Loving God and serving others. (vv.15-18, 21)

 Speaking <u>kindly</u> and giving <u>thanks</u>. (vv.19-20)

Key Truth:

When it comes to marriage and family, *showing* grace is just as important as *saving* grace.

- 1. This week I will read the Scripture and pray daily so that Jesus, who is full of grace, can empower me to show grace to those around me.
- This week I will look for opportunities to serve my spouse/family and express gratitude and appreciation for who they are and what they do.
