## 2. Will this action *encourage* others?

For I am not seeking my own good but the good of many, so that they may be saved." - 1 Corinthians 10:32-33 "All things are lawful for me, but not all things are helpful; all things are lawful for me, but not all things edify." - 1 Corinthians10:23
