- **Guardrails Definition** A system designed to keep *people* or vehicles from straying into *dangerous* or *off-limits* areas.
- **Guardrails Principle** Guardrails are designed not to keep us from something good, but to keep us from something bad.

3 Guardrails that will keep us from going over the cliff financially:

- 1. <u>Give</u> 10%
- 2. <u>Save</u> 10%
- 3. <u>Spend</u> 80%

3 Financial Principles:

1. The principle of *accounting*.

"Be sure you know the condition of your flocks, give careful attention to your herds; for riches do not endure forever and a crown is not secure for all generations." Proverbs 27:23-24 NIV

2. The principle of *budgeting*.

"Plan carefully and you'll have plenty. But if you act too quickly you will never have enough." Proverbs 21:5 GNT

3. The principle of *contentment*.

"It is better to be satisfied with what you have than always to be wanting something more." Ecclesiastes 6:9 GNT
