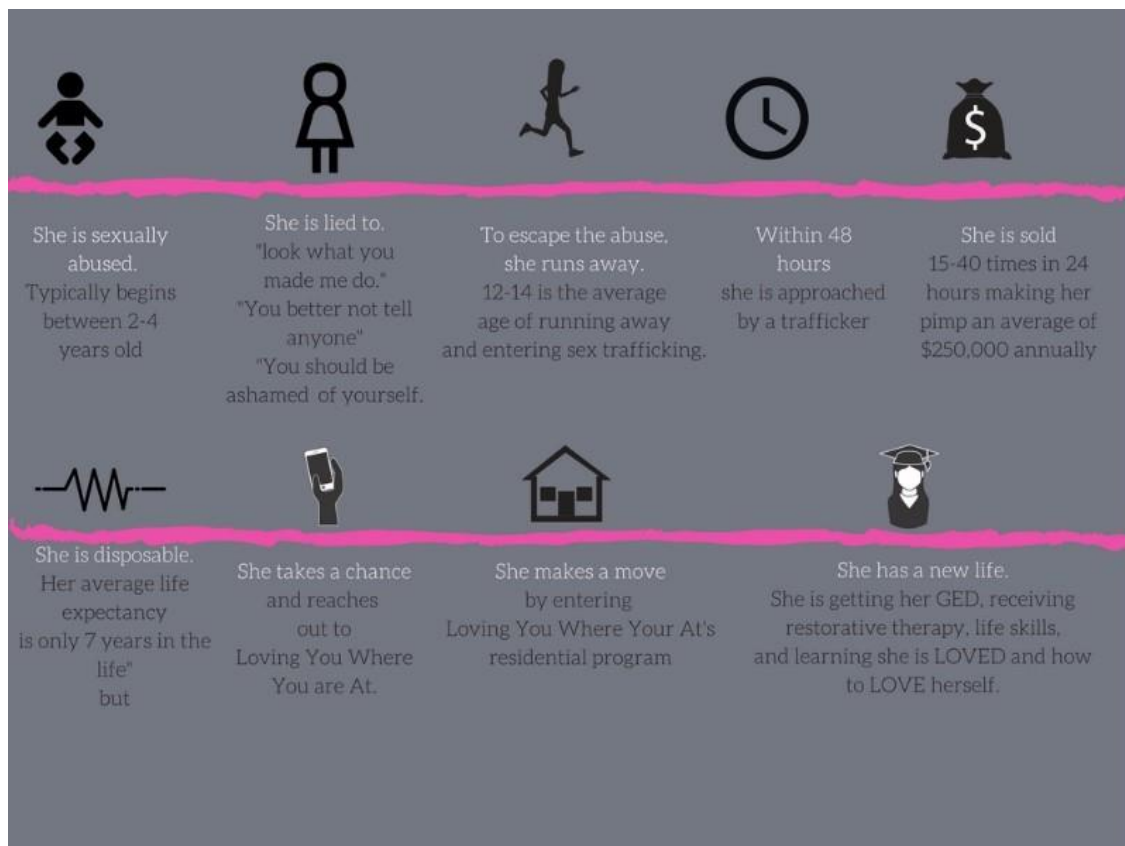

Tampa is number 1 per capita for the most adult registered businesses. We know that %70percent of females are trafficked into the commercial sex industry. There are currently only 2 residential programs for 18 + sex trafficking survivors in Florida. There are less than 200 beds nation wide. Loving You Where You Are At will launch a sustainable three phase, 12 month program that will provide restorative programming for adult women survivors.

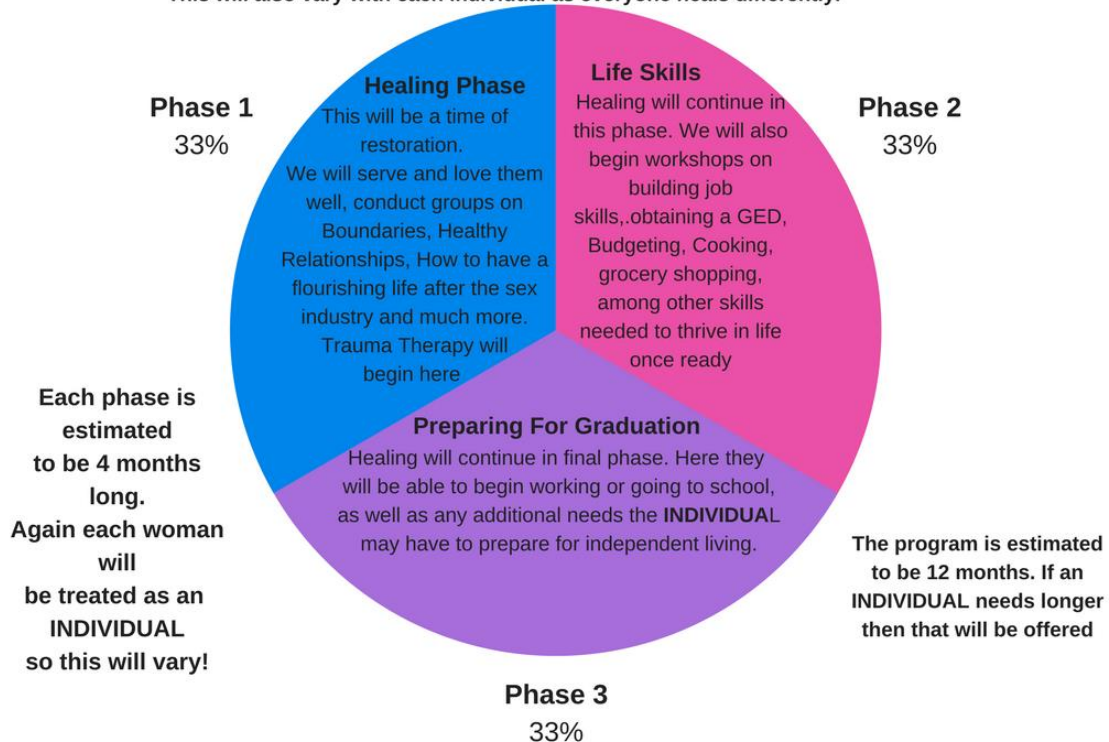


This is only a little bit of what we will offer. This is to give you, our supporters a general idea.
This will also vary with each individual as everyone heals differently.



We have a house! Praise God! Even after having the house we will still need funds to run it. We have included an image above that breaks down an estimate of what it will cost to run this home annually. This will be a twelve month, three-phase program. For some precious women we serve it could be longer. We will treat each woman on an individual basis. We are aware everyone heals differently and this won't be a cookie cutter program. There are only two homes in the Greater Tampa Bay Area for women who have been sexually exploited. There are now less than 200 beds for women 18+ in the United States. This is a great need. We can't tell you how many times we are frantically trying to find safe places for women to go. Many times we have to get them out-of-state due to no housing and unfortunately sometimes we can't find anywhere. You can be a part of ensuring we have a place for these women to go and begin to restore their lives. This home will house at least 6 women and possibly 8. We will not go above that number as we want this to feel like a family atmosphere.


