

LIFEgroup Leader Description and Check List

Position:

LIFEgroup Leader (Adult Small Group Bible Study Leader)

Leader's Goals:

- Lead a small group of 8 to 12 adults in a Sermon Based Bible study, Men's or Ladies' Topical, or LlfeCARE Group
- Lead the group in our community your home or host home once a week or every other week
- Pray for group members daily
- Record weekly attendance
- Stay in communication with the LIFEgroup Office and your LIFEgroup coach
- Disciple your group to a point of multiplying disciple-makers and birthing a new leader to lead a new group
- Shepherd and care for your flock

Time Commitment:

LIFEgroups are set up on a semester system where groups meet and then take the summer off. There is a break for rest or Sabbath in between each semester. We believe that Scripture teaches that there is a time to work and there is a need to have a time to rest.

Fall Semester: September, October, and November (12-13 weeks) Winter Semester: January, February, and March (7-8 weeks) Spring Semester: April - May (6-7 weeks)

*Qualifications:

- ____ Be a growing, born-again believer in Jesus Christ
- ____ Must have attended a FFC LIFEgroup in the past
- Attended Discover FFC Membership Seminar (formerly FH 101) and completed FFC membership
- ____ Complete LAUNCH New LIFEgroup Leader Seminar prior to launching your group

- 2. Submit a confidential volunteer background check form
- 3. Have a one-on-one meeting (discussion) with a LIFEgroup Coach, the Discipleship Pastor in charge of LIFEgroups or a LIFEgroup Office Team Leader
- 4. Submit FFC Leadership covenant
- ____ 5. Submit LIFEgroup Leader covenant
